Items needed for verification:

- Birth Certificate of each child up to 14 years old in your household.
- Financial need (MassHealth Card, WIC, SSI, current pay stub, etc.).
- Photo ID for each adult living in the household.
- Proof of residence (current home, gas, cable, utility bill, etc.).
- Proof of guardianship if not a parent.

Christmas in the City – Thanksgiving and Christmas Assistance

Families currently living in a homeless shelter in the Boston area may be able to get gifts for their children through their shelter via the Christmas in the City: Delivered program. CITC: Delivered is working with several congregate shelters to provide presents around the holidays. Check with your shelter manager to see if CITC: Delivered is working with your shelter managers are welcome to contact them at info@christmasinthecity.org for more information. Please note, for 2023, there will not be a party at the convention center. Christmas in the City will NOT be providing Thanksgiving assistance this year.

For those in need, but not experiencing homelessness: Jake's Toy Mania provides gifts for Boston-area families for children 16 and under. You must register in advance, in person. Dates and locations for registration have not yet been finalized. Please check their website for updated info.

USPS – Writing to Santa Program

USPS offers the Operation Santa Program to pair letters from kids and families with generous people who fulfill their holiday wishes.

This program provides a connection to gift and clothing donations.

Children can write their wish list to send to Santa starting November 28th. Letters to USPS Operation Santa must be postmarked no later than December 12. Anyone can write a letter, but please note that the program relies on the generosity of others and cannot guarantee a gift. My Brother's Keeper - Christmas Assistance General Information:

- All services are free.
- Assistance is provided by delivery only no pick-ups at the facility.

• The Christmas Assistance Program serves families all over eastern Massachusetts including Boston and Cape Cod. It does not serve Framingham or locations west.

- All requests are processed by phone. The program cannot accept e-mail requests or requests made in-person at the facility due to staffing limitations.
- The Christmas Assistance Line is often busy because it serves families from so many communities.
- The program will ask for the names, birthdates, clothing size, and gift ideas for each person in your family living at your home.
- My Brother's Keeper only accepts requests from parents in need. it does not accept second-hand requests from family, friends, or advocates. (For example, "I'm calling for a friend who needs help.")
- Gift ideas are suggestions only- My Brother's Keeper does not guarantee to provide specific gifts.
- My Brother's Keeper cannot give out high-end electronic items like iPods, cell phones, or game systems.
- Gifts are delivered directly to homes sometime between December 1st 24th. Program volunteers call ahead to schedule delivery appointments. To help with scheduling, intake staff will always ask for two telephone numbers when processing requests.

How to request gifts for your family:

If your family could use assistance this holiday season, follow the instructions below so Globe Santa can help. <u>https://globesanta.org/aboutreq.aspx</u>

Globe Santa does not accept family letters without a holiday gift verification form. Families who have children 12 years old or younger and live in Globe Santa's delivery **area** (follow link: <u>https://globesanta.org/aboutreq.aspx</u> and click on the map)can submit a holiday gift verification form from the **Department of Transitional Assistance** (**DTA**) or another approved agency.

Follow these steps to request holiday gifts for children:

- 1. Tell your story. Write a letter to Globe Santa describing your situation or telling them why you are seeking holiday gifts for your children. You will not include a wish list or gift ideas.
- 2. Finish your forms. Complete and sign your Holiday Gift Verification Form from the Department of Transitional Assistance (DTA) or another approved agency.
- 3. Check envelope contents. Before you send your request, confirm your family letter and verification form are included in the envelope. Letters received without a verification form cannot be processed!
- 4. **Mail your request**. Send your letter and completed verification form to the following address **by November 5th**:

About DTA Holiday Gift Verification Forms

- Families who receive DTA assistance, who live in the coverage area, and who have children 12 years old or younger can submit to Globe Santa a Holiday Gift Verification Form. If you have not received your verification form, contact the DTA at (877) 382-2363.
- Your Holiday Gift Verification Form must include your current address and a complete list of the eligible children in your household.

If the Holiday Gift Verification Form is not correct, you can notify DTA in one of the following ways:

1. Best way: Update your information using DTA Connect. Print the screen from DTA Connect that shows your updated address or additional children. Mail this printed page along with your completed Holiday Gift Verification Form that includes your Globe Santa letter on the back. Mail your holiday gift verification form and letters to:

2. Another way: Visit your local DTA office to update your information and request a new Holiday Gift Verification Form. Mail this updated Holiday Gift Verification Form, along with your Globe Santa letter on the back. Please call Globe Santa at 617-929-2002 if you have any questions.

Other Resources for Free Toys for Kids this Holiday Season:

- Local churches can be valuable resources and many help families in need during the holidays.
- Local Buy Nothing Facebook groups and Freecycle are often suitable places to find free second-hand toys.
- Your child's Primary Care Provider may be able to provide information on whether their office, hospital, or clinic has a holiday toy event for their patients.

• If your child/youth is receiving Behavioral n-home therapy, Behavioral outpatient therapy, or if an Intensive Care Coordinator or Family Partner is working with you and your family, these providers are also often a major source of support for holiday assistance.

Holiday Food Assistance:

- Families can connect with their clinic and ask if they have a food pantry or holiday meal assistance.
- More clinics are now opening food pantries in their facilities for patients.
